We wish to inform you that as part of the Subject Enrichment Activity, we are assigning an investigatory project on the topic **Migration**.

The *objectives* of the project are as follows:



- To gain an insight into the birds, animals and insects that migrates.
- To analyze various reasons for migration.
- To project an understanding of how different animals, birds and insects remember their path during migration.

Skills Involved:

- Research skills, Organizational skills, IT skills and Communication skills

Criteria of Judgement: Students would be assessed based on the following criteria

- Relevant research. (2 Marks)
- Analysis, Knowledge, Interpretation of the information (3 Marks)
- Map work (1 Mark)
- Timely submission. (1 Mark)
- Viva (3 Marks)
- ***Format:***
 - Should be in the form of a booklet, with the topic/title on the first page and acknowledgement on the second page. (A4 page only)
 - It should contain names of the birds, animals and insects (minimum 3 animals or birds or insects) researched, picture and information about the chosen animal, bird or insect like its regular habitat and process of migration.
 - Should show the path of migration on the world map for each animal researched.
- The booklet should end with a bibliography that includes links of websites used to gather information, the title of the books referred and names of the authors.
