Domestic Tour

Dear Parent

We are delighted to inform that 91 Gangians with 11 teachers will undertake a memorable journey on 27th September by Telangana Express at 0625 hours from Nampally railway station (students to report to the railway station by 0515 hours on 27th September, 2019) to the Golden Triangle - Agra, Delhi and Jaipur for 6 days. Return journey is on 2nd October 2019 by flight, the details of which , will be shared with the itinerary by 20th September, 2019.

1. The students will be divided into 11 groups with a teacher heading each group. The ratio would be 1:8.
2. They shall be given rooms on four sharing basis.
3. There will be a roll call every morning before breakfast by the teacher.
4. Students of each group must stay together, and the teacher will always take a head count before leaving the hotel, in public places and return to the hotel.
5. All groups MUST always stay close to each other and follow the instructions of the teachers.
6. Delhi is a warm city even in early October. Therefore, the following are a Must Have's in the baggage:
 - a. Cotton shirts and tee shirts(according to the number of days)
 - b. Casual shorts (boys) and couple of cotton trousers/jeans
 - c. Comfortable sneakers (avoid a new pair) and a pair of slippers (No heels)
 - d. A pair of socks for each day.
 - e. Toiletries with hand sanitiser.
 - f. Cap and water bottle.
 - g. A cotton jacket. May be handy in the aircraft or in the evenings.
 - h. Students can carry some snacks but ensure we do not litter our bus, street, etc.
 - i. A small hand towel
 - j. A small trolley suitcase and a backpack is the maximum you can carry. Remember the return journey by flight will allow maximum of 15 kg only . (anything above the required will incur extra expenditure to be borne by the student.)

Delhi is a place for tourists with plenty of places to see, enjoy and learn a lot. The itinerary shared before surely tells you that the students are going to enjoy themselves. However, there are some Do's and Don't's that one must bear in mind before travelling there.

You must educate your ward, along with us, to ensure the following:

1. It is absolutely essential that we **Do Not Litter** streets, tourist places, restaurants.
2. One thing we must adhere to is **Queue**. Always maintain that when at the railway station, airport, shops, restaurant, tourist places to purchase ticket etc, **Never ever cut a line**.
3. **Being polite is a must**. "Thank you", "Sorry", "Excuse me", "Pardon me", should be an important part of our vocabulary. In terms of volume, ensure that we **Do not shout and scream** while talking in the bus, otherwise we attract unnecessary attention.
4. **Follow traffic rules**. Cross the road only when we see green light.
5. **We cannot stand in the bus**. We will be travelling in our own bus all the time, but still nobody can stand.
6. **Do not run to a table in a restaurant**. We will be guided to one.
7. We suggest Rs 5000 is the maximum they should carry. **Students will be responsible for the money they carry**.
8. Students can carry their own mobile phones; **however, they will be entirely responsible for it**.
9. We will create a WhatsApp group by 20th September, 2019. Any further discussions / clarifications can be posted in a cordial manner.
10. We will have a first aid kit for emergency purpose. We do hope that none of the students travelling are on any specific medication that you have not shared with us.

We, at Ganges, make it a point to always groom our students and the points given above are only a reaffirmation of the same.
